Updated 12/02/2014

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- The Burnaby 4 Day will take place on the time and date scheduled
- There will be no extension of the event past December 30th due to unforeseen delays or stoppages. Racing format may also be modified at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire or Event Organizer in response to prolonged stoppages.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- Medical problems should be reported at the time of registration.
- The event will be run under Cycling Canada/UCI rules where applicable.
- All racers must have a valid UCI or Cycling BC license.

Internet/Wi-Fi Access

- Due to limited bandwidth during the event, personal Wi-Fi will not be available during the event.

Eligibility

- All non-residents of BC must possess a valid UCI license.
- Domestic licenses from other countries will not be accepted.
- Residents of BC may hold either a UCI or citizen's license.
- Participation in the Elite Men's Madison is by invitation only; invitation to participate in the event does not guarantee free race entry.
- C=Category 4 riders, B=strong Category 4 riders and Category 3 riders
- Registration in a category may be switched to another category at the race organizer's discretion.
- No registrations will be accepted on the day of the event.
- License must be presented at race package pickup.
- Riders in the Elite Madison must wear the Madison jerseys provided, no exceptions.
- **Aggressive behavior towards race officials, volunteers, participants, and spectators will not be tolerated. Violators will be removed from the building for the duration of the event.**

Venue

The Burnaby Velodrome is situated within the Harry Jerome Sports Centre, located just below Simon Fraser University on the Barnet Highway in Burnaby. The Velodrome was built by Cycling BC and numerous volunteers between 1991 and 1997, and opened its doors in November 1997 as the first indoor velodrome in North America.

The Burnaby Velodrome is, without a doubt, one of the most exciting cycling tracks in North America. Its relatively short length (200m) and steep banking (47degrees) make riding and racing far more thrilling than at the big outdoor velodromes.

Ticketing

Adult admission is \$5, children 12 and under are free.

Registration

- Registration will close at 11:59pm PST on December 22nd, 2014
- Subject to UCI rules 9.2.008 and 12.2.001, once a rider is registered and on the official start list they will be fined \$50 should they not appear on the start line or delay the start of an event.
- Race packages can be picked up between 1:00-4:00pm on Saturday December 27th for all categories.

Accreditation

Accreditation is required for athletes and support staff to access any areas of the velodrome that are not open to the public. The maximum number of accreditations is as follows:

- One to two athletes: one staff
- Three athletes: two staff
- Four athletes: three staff
- Five athletes or more: four staff

Team boxes will be allocated to each Elite Madison team and to Elite Women's riders. Other team boxes may be allocated as necessary or based on a first come, first served basis. Riders are not allowed to claim a team box prior to 1:00pm on Saturday December 27th.

Gear Restrictions

There will be no gear restrictions imposed on B, C, and Masters category races. However, for all youth riders, in the interests of fair play, the following gear/equipment restrictions will be enforced:

Jerseys and Prizes

A Vie 13 Champion's Jersey will be awarded to the following categories: Elite Madison, Elite Women, B, C, and Masters Men 40+. All other categories will compete for prizes.

In addition to the jerseys, Elite Madison and Elite Women riders will compete for prize money. The amount to be confirmed at a later date.

Important

- All athletes who have placed on the podium must attend the award ceremonies. Failure to do so will result in a fine and a loss of award (including prize money if available).
- Riders must wear cycling apparel to the award ceremony, with the exception of running shoes. Failure to do so will result in a fine and loss of award.
- No headbands or sunglasses on the podium.
- Elite Madison riders are expected to wear their Madison jerseys on the podium. Failure to do so will result in a fine and loss of award.
